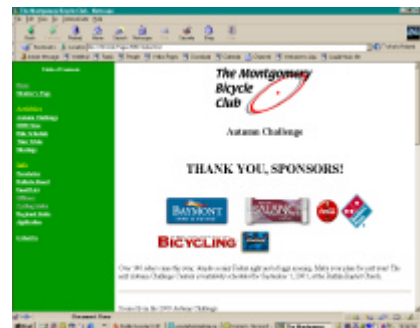
The MBC Email Mailing List
